

NMSU Board of Regents to attend Student Success Committee Event

The Board of Regents of New Mexico State University are invited to participate in a Regents' Student Success Committee day of events featuring Dr. Tim Renick of Georgia State University. The events will be held from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm on the Main Campus of New Mexico State University. Meetings will be held in Hadley Hall and Domenici Hall.

On Friday, Oct. 28, Tim Renick, vice provost and vice president for Enrollment Management and Student Success at Georgia State University and renowned expert in student retention and closing the achievement gap, will speak at New Mexico State University on the role of faculty and staff in student engagement and retention. Renick led Georgia State University's retention efforts, which have increased graduation rates dramatically for all students and have closed the achievement gap between minority and non-minority students.
