NEW MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY BOARD OF REGENTS

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, general obligation bond items are a traditional method of financing educational facilities in the State of New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, General Obligation Bond issues D and B will have a positive impact on higher education in New Mexico and the New Mexico State University system and does not include an increase in taxes;

WHEREAS, the projects in Bond D include \$25 million for renovations and modernization of College of Agricultural, Consumer, and Environmental Sciences facilities in Las Cruces; \$1.7 million for Doña Ana Community College; \$1.4 million for NMSU-Alamogordo; \$1.6 million to NMSU-Carlsbad, and \$1.5 million to NMSU-Grants.


WHEREAS, Bond Issue B includes funding for New Mexico academic libraries, including an estimated \$610,000 for NMSU System libraries;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED in official session that the Board of Regents of New Mexico State University thank voters for approving GO Bond C in 2016 resulting in construction of a building for the NMSU Department of Art, and endorses and supports Bond Issue D for higher education and Bond Issue B for libraries, on the November 6, 2018 general election ballot in New Mexico.
